

PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION	The ability to facilitate the development of students' digital competence has become an integral part of teachers' professional demands. Findings of some researches on this topic show a lack of didactical and pedagogical elements in guidelines provided to perform such tasks and a poor mediation role played in facilitating learners' digital competence.
WHAT DO WE KNOW ABOUT THE PROBLEM?	We know that some teachers are not even confident in using digital resources, which is the starting point in solving the problem that they should be facilitators in learners' digital competencies.

Support learners in using digital technologies in innovative ways to create knowledge, being creative and express themselves 3. WHAT DID WE LEARN? PROBLEM SOLUTION	Teachers have a role in the case of online learning to help students master digital resources if they have problems. The question is, how can they do it? The solution is that teachers must first be the ones who control the process of online learning.
